The Glassolutions environmental policy is to prevent pollution, continually improve its environmental performance and to comply with or exceed the requirements of all applicable environmental legislation.


Glassolutions is committed to implementing a formal environmental management system, which meets the requirements of ISO14001 for all its activities. Targets will be set and progress monitored by each operating unit for one or more of the following objectives:

- A minimisation of waste
- A reduction in the consumption of energy
- A reduction in the consumption of water
- A reduction in emissions to atmosphere
- A reduction in releases to water, in line with trade consents

To assign environmental responsibility throughout the company:

- The Managing Director is responsible for overall environmental obligations and performance
- The Manufacturing Director is responsible for overall implementation
- The Business Sector Leaders are responsible for the obligations and performance of their operating units and for cascading implementation to site managers
- Local Managers are responsible for the management of environmental obligations and performance and for achieving progress against agreed targets.
- All employees are responsible for ensuring high standards of environmental care.

The Environmental Policy will be reviewed at regular intervals and updated as required, and progress against specific objectives and targets will be reported at least annually. Awareness and responsibility training will be made available to all employees in environmental matters.
